

IPDLN Executive Committee Membership Elections

We are pleased to announce that elections to be part of the International Population Data Linkage Network Executive Committee for 2023-2024 are now open!

Nominations for Committee Members will be sought based on the following criteria:

- The nominee must be a member of the IPDLN as per the Member record database on 30 June 2022 and demonstrated prior involvement with the IPDLN to be eligible.
- Current IPDLN Executive Committee Members who have served less than two terms are also eligible for re-election

Additionally, the current Executive Committee can identify candidates and present them to the membership.

Submission Criteria

The applicant must provide their:

- Name
- Title
- Institutional affiliations
- Qualifications
- A brief biography
- A brief outline of previous and/or potential contributions to the IPDLN

Nominations should be **200 words max, size 12 font of your choice, and submitted in PDF format to hub@adruk.org.**

Deadline for nominations is 31 October 2022.

The 2023-2024 Executive Committee will include the current IPDLN co-directors and the editor-in-chief of the International Journal of Population Data Science as ex-officio members.

The Elections Process

IPDLN Executive Committee members will be elected by a simple majority vote of IPDLN members.

An elections process for Executive Committee Members will only take place if there are more than 5 eligible nominees. If only 5 nominations are received and the nominees are considered suitable by the current directors/executive committee, they will be accepted and duly elected to the Executive Committee.
